

Installing the Mosquito Guard

The Mosquito Guard is a mesh netting that is sewn to the right smoke flap. It has three ribbons connected to it, which will make it easier to maneuver. Before you tie your tipi cover to the lift pole, please untie those ribbons, so they hang loose.

As shown in the set-up instruction on page 11, picture 27, spread the cover around the poles and bring it together between the door pole and the #1 pole. Bring the right side over the #1 pole first.

Now use the loose ribbons to stretch the Mosquito Guard across the door pole and the poles to the left of the door pole. The netting and all three ribbons should always be on the outside of the poles, between the cover and the poles. A ladder inside the tipi will help you to stretch the very top of the netting around the pole cluster. Tie all three ribbons to the poles.





Now spread the left part of the tipi cover over the Mosquito Guard. Lace your cover together with the lacing pins. This method will cover 95% of the opening at the top with netting (2).

To finish off, use your smoke flap poles to stretch out the smoke flaps. Please remember to cut your smoke flap poles to a length 2ft taller than the size of your tipi (a 20ft diameter tipi needs 22ft long smoke flap poles).
